Our obedience, or our disobedience, it influences three things.

1. Urban Legend: I'm not a bad person

1 John 1:8 "If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us."

Isaiah 64:6 and all our righteous acts are like filthy rags;

2. Urban Legend: All sin is the same

1. It influences our rewards in Heaven

2. It influences punishment in hell

3. It also influences consequences on earth

Luke 12:47-48 "And a servant who knows what the master wants, but isn't prepared and doesn't carry out those instructions, will be severely punished. But someone who does not know, and then does something wrong, will be punished only lightly. When someone has been given much, much will be required in return; and when someone has been entrusted with much, even more will be required."

Luke 20:46-47 “Beware of the teachers of the law. They like to walk around in flowing robes and love to be greeted in the marketplaces and have the most important seats in the synagogues and the places of honor at banquets. They devour widows’ houses and for a show make lengthy prayers. Such men will be punished most severely.”

James 1:14-15 Temptation comes from our own desires, which entice us and drag us away. These desires give birth to sinful actions. And when sin is allowed to grow, it gives birth to death.

Revelation 3:19 Those whom I love I rebuke and discipline. So be earnest, and repent.

3. Urban Legend: I’ve already sinned, I might as well keep going

2 Peter 2:20 And when people escape from the wickedness of the world by knowing our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and then get tangled up and enslaved by sin again, they are worse off than before.
