How do we use faith to conquer fear?

1. Information.

Proverbs 13:16 "Every prudent man acts out of knowledge."

Proverbs 23:23 (LB) "Get the facts at any price."

2. Evaluation.

Luke 14:28, 31 Jesus says. "Don't begin until you count the cost. Who would begin construction of a building without first getting estimates..." Or what king would dream of going to war without first sitting down with his counselors...?"

Proverbs 20:25 "It is a trap...to dedicate something rashly and only later consider his vows."

3. Preparation.

Proverbs 14:15 "A prudent man gives thought to his steps."

Proverbs 16:9 "We should make our plans, counting on God to direct us."

Proverbs 20:18 "Make plans by seeking advice."

4. Declaration.

James 4:15 "What you should say is this, 'If the Lord is willing, we will live and do this or that.'"

5. Initiation.

Psalms 56:3 "When I am afraid, I will put my confidence in God... Yes, I will trust the promises of God."

The Obstacle of Fear

Hebrews 12:1

Let us strip off every weight that slows us down, especially the sin that so easily trips us up. And let us run with endurance the race God has set before us.

What does fear do to us?

1. Fear makes us skeptical.

Exodus 14:11

As Pharaoh approached, the Israelites looked up and saw them—Egyptians! Coming at them! They were totally afraid. They cried out in terror to GOD. They told

Moses, “Weren’t the cemeteries large enough in Egypt so that you had to take us out here in the wilderness to die?”

2. Fear makes us selfish.

12 What have you done to us, taking us out of Egypt? Back in Egypt didn’t we tell you this would happen?

3. Fear makes us stubborn.

12 Didn’t we tell you, ‘Leave us alone here in Egypt—we’re better off as slaves in Egypt than as corpses in the wilderness.’”
